### GUIDELINES FOR BRAZORIA-GALVESTON COUNTY FARM BUREAU JACKO GARRETT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP 2024

- I. The Scholarship Committee of Brazoria-Galveston County Farm Bureau will select an individual to receive the \$4,000 scholarship.
- II. To be eligible to receive the scholarship, an applicant must:
  - a. Be a graduating high school senior of a Brazoria County high school or a home school student residing in Brazoria County.
  - b. Turn in completed application form accompanied by a high school transcript, SAT and/or ACT test results (if applicable) and three (3) letters of reference.
  - c. Plan to attend a college, technical or trade school and take a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester. (Will be required to provide proof of registration.)
  - d. Be the son or daughter of a current Brazoria-Galveston County Farm Bureau member. If awarded, parents must maintain membership for the duration of the scholarship.
  - e. Submit application no later than January 26, 2024.
- III. The money will be paid directly to the college/school as follows:
  - 1st Year-\$500 the fall semester upon proof of registration for a minimum of 12 credit hours. \$500 the spring semester, upon proof of registration for a minimum of 12 credit hours and a minimum 2.0 GPA maintained the preceding semester.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Year-\$500 the fall semester and \$500 the spring semester with registration for 12 credit hours minimum and minimum 2.0 GPA the preceding semester.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Year- \$500 the fall semester and \$500 the spring semester with registration for 12 credit hours minimum and minimum 2.0 GPA the preceding semester.
  - 4<sup>th</sup> Year-\$500 the fall semester and \$500 the spring semester with registration for 12 credit hours minimum and a minimum 2.0 GPA the preceding semester. *Scholarship stops if at any time the requirements for a semester are not met*.

### 2024 SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Scholarship awards will be given to selected outstanding Brazoria County 12<sup>th</sup> grade students pursuing a career in any field.

### Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating 12<sup>th</sup> grade high school student currently enrolled in a state-accredited school and a resident of Brazoria County.
- 2. Applicant must be a resident of Brazoria County and at least one parent or guardian must be a current member of the Brazoria County Fair Association. (Annual or Life Membership accepted) Current meaning for the graduation year
- 3. Applicant must have competed in a scheduled fair sponsored competition for at least two years in his/her 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> grade year. This includes any off-season fair sponsored event. Fair Parade does not qualify as a competition.
- 4. Applicant must be planning to attend a 2 or 4 year accredited or approved college or university, or trade school.
- 5. Scholarship payments, to include books, tuition, and related fees, will be made to the college, university, or trade school of the winners' choice. In the case of trade school recipients, payment schedule may be adjusted to meet different semester and total term requirements.
- 6. Selection of the scholarship winner will be made by the Brazoria County Fair Association, Inc., and will be announced at each respective school's award program.
- 7. Student must complete and pass 12 semester/quarter hours maintaining a 2.0 grade point average or will forfeit scholarship. Exception would be for a student being accepted into a program that does not meet the 12 semester/quarter hours. Hours will not include retaking a class already taken to better a grade. Scholarship funds WILL NOT cover tuition for mini semesters.

- 9. Semester grades and proof of enrollment for the upcoming semester must be sent to the Brazoria County Fair office before next semester is paid.
- 10. Merit must exist to be awarded a scholarship.
- 11. Scholarship funds will not be paid out for summer school semesters taken.
- 12. Scholarship funds will be paid in 4 consecutive semesters (or quarters if trade school) to include Fall and Spring semesters only. Exception may be made with prior approval from Scholarship committee.
